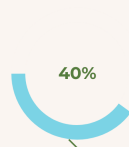


### Annual Events

## Data & Statistics on Autism Spectrum Disorder

According to the CDC, autism effects 1 in 54 children in the United States.



Approximately 40% of people with autism are nonverbal.



On average, autism costs an estimated \$60,000 a year through childhood.



Among children identified with ASD, one-third (33%) also had an intellectual disability.
